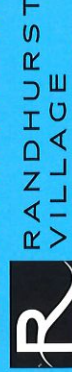

WARNING OF RISK

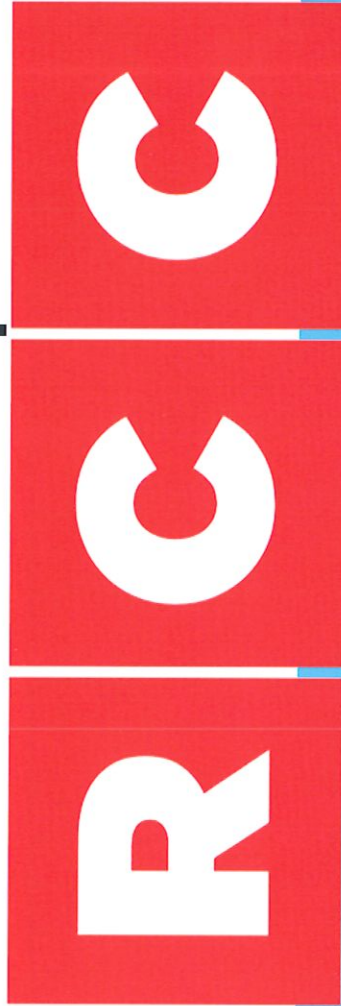
