

- Please register early or by session deadline! There will be a 48 hour deferment period after any late registration. You will be notified within two business days if we will be able to accommodate you. No friendship requests will be granted with late registration.
- Transfers and Withdrawals must be made 48 hours prior to Camp Session starting date. Once program starts, refunds will be prorated and credits will be applied to your account.
- Please register your child by their grade as of Fall 2020.
- There will be no fee adjustments for time your child doesn't attend a session.
