

SWIM LESSONS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

PURPOSE OF PROGRAM

Mount Prospect Lions Club and River Trails Park District believes everyone should learn the life skill of swimming.

It is the intent of the Mount Prospect Lions Club and River Trails Park District to teach our community the importance of water safety and how to swim. Together, we are giving opportunities to our community that is facing financial hardship by providing this scholarship program.

The Cost of the program will be waived.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Proof of financial need must be provided to qualify. Items that will be considered when evaluating include current participation in public aid, food stamp program, school free lunch program, subsidized housing program, excessive medical bills and/or fall within the poverty guidelines. Providing your Federal Tax Return is a must.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- 1.) Scholarship participants must reside within Village Mount Prospect or the boundaries of the River Trails Park District.
- 2.) All information on the application must be true and accurate and will be kept confidential. Scholarships are legally recoverable if awarded on the basis of false information supplied by the applicant and will nullify the request for a scholarship.
- 3.) All Scholarships will be awarded on a first come first serve basis, on the basis of need. River Trails Park District reserves the right to approve or deny applicant's request.
- 4.) An application must be completed once a year when request for financial assistance/scholarship is made. Granting of assistance/scholarship does not ensure continued approval for succeeding sessions.
- 5.) Once a properly completed application is received, the park district will make every effort to process the request within (2) weeks.
- 6.) The Scholarship is only for general group learn to swim program. It does not include semi private or private swim lessons.
